OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Place one gloved hand on the strap and position yourself so that you are not in the path of the strapping.
- 2. Cut the strap several inches away from your hand. The cut should be made so that the flying strap is too short to reach any part of the body.
- 3. Strapping should be cut squarely, not at an angle, to avoid sharp strap edges.
- 4. Immediately dispose of all strapping to avoid accidents and injury.

SAFETY WARNINGS:

- Keep fingers away from areas that can pinch or cut. These areas are located at the front of the tool.
- Only use equipment recommended for the strap. The MIP-2100 is recommended only for .015-.031 gauge steel strap, 3/8" 3/4" wide.
- Review the instructions and safety material on a regular basis.
- Warning: Improper use may result in blindness, severe laceration, amputation, or death.
